TRUE LOVE..

...what is it, exactly? That's an easy question, right? So easy that Cinderella sang a song about it! "So this is love? So this is what makes life divine!" Or as another character famously put it, "Sonny, true love is the greatest thing in the world, except for a nice MLT — mutton, lettuce and tomato sandwich..." Our culture has lots of ideas about love! Some are humorous, but others are distorted and sinful since they are generated by a world that rejects God and His Son. Thankfully, we can know the truth about love from God Himself! In fact, His Word summarized the whole concept in just three words: "God is love." (1 John 4:16) What a comforting truth, that God not only created love and understands it, but He embodies it!

God has showed His love for us in some remarkable ways, most notably by sending His only Son to pay the debt for our sin. Instead of making us pay for our own sin in a place of eternal suffering, God offers an eternal home in heaven to all who will trust in Him alone. "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." (John 3:16) Now that's true love! God's Word also tells us that His love is without limits. It's not like human love, limited by our own sin and weakness. We often grow weary of loving others as we should. We are tempted to stop loving when the cost is too great to our own comfort or energy. We sometimes want to quit when we are giving to others without receiving anything in return. But God's love is not like that it is perfect and pure, and it never runs out. In Ephesians 3 we are told that we can be "filled with all the fulness of God" if we can just get a firm grip on God's love to us: "...that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God."

How does God want us to respond to His great love? First, He wants us to accept His gift forgiveness and receive Jesus Christ as our Savior! Then He enables us to learn to love *like Him*—in a way that sacrifices our own needs and desires for the good of others. Living this way is a task beyond our human ability, but God easily strengthens us: "What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? ...Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us." (Romans 8:31, 37)
