# FAITH DOES

Faith is simple, isn't it? We trust an alarm clock, so we set it by faith believing it will wake us up tomorrow. We trust GPS, so we leave home with our charged cell phone, trusting it to lead us where we need to go. We trust in the laws of nature, so we don't feel anxious about whether we will have air to breathe tomorrow or whether gravity might stop working and leave us floating into outer space!

But in the spiritual realm, faith seems to be often misunderstood—so much so that God gave us much information in His Word to help us understand it. For one thing, He tells us how to get faith: "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." (Romans 10:17) In this passage, Paul has just been explaining that people cannot believe what they have not heard. Faith can only begin with exposure to the truth of God's Word. He also lets us know that faith is a gift from Him: "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:" (Ephesians 2:80) While faith is a gift from God, faith is a choice that any person can make in response to what God says: "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." (John 3:16) We are instructed to trust in the Lord, implying that we can choose to trust in Him: "Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding." (Proverbs 3:5) God even tells us that we cannot please Him without faith (Hebrews 11:6)!

But what does true faith in God look like in practice? The Bible is clear that real faith always results in good works—obedience. When a person believes in Christ for salvation from sin, they are "born again," (made spiritually alive) and given a brand-new desire to obey God (Ephesians 2:1-10). Hebrews 11 lists many people who had faith, and how that faith produced obedience to God. Among those mentioned are Noah, Abraham, Moses, even Rahab and Samson. Though far from perfect, these men and women exercised faith by doing what God asked them to do. May God help us to do the same until our faith is made sight!
