WHAT IS THANKSGIVING?

It's a day in November when we eat more than we should, right? Some of us even take turns around the dinner table, listing things we are most thankful for! But although the Thanksgiving holiday helps us remember to give thanks, "thanksgiving" is much more than a holiday! It's an attitude and action that, for a Christian, can and should last all year. Consider God's command to us in I Thessalonians 5:18: "In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you." Since God doesn't command us to do things that we cannot do (Philippians 4:13), we know that thanksgiving is a choice we can make, consistently. When we choose to give thanks to God, even during difficulties, we are showing that we trust Him. Trusting in God and resting in His good, unchanging character is the foundation for a lifestyle of thanksgiving! Here's three aspects of God's character that, when we trust in them, will help us have the perspective to thank God in every circumstance: (1) God is all-powerful and nothing can prevent Him from accomplishing His plan (Isaiah 14:27), (2) God is all-wise and knows infinitely better than we do, even when it comes to what is good for us (Psalm 147:5), and (3) God loves us and is always working everything out for our good as His children (Romans 8:28-29). In short, God has the power to do anything, He has the wisdom to know how to best use His power, and He loves us and will always do what is best for His children. When our hearts are discontent or complaining, we reveal that we either don't know or remember who God is, or we don't believe Him. Instead, let's trust in Him and make thanksgiving the habit of our lives! Our thankfulness will please God and will produce joy in our own hearts!
