The _____ family has served as missionaries to Jordan since 2000. In 2004, Brother _____ started _____ Baptist Church, located in the capital and largest city of Amman. This city, named after the ancient Ammonites that lived there (descended from Lot’s daughter), has a long standing history of idolatrous worship. This trend continues, as almost all inhabitants of modern Amman worship the false god Allah. But the Lord is using Christians and missionaries like the Haddads to ensure that the Gospel is present in Jordan and available for those who are seeking to know the true God!



In addition to his pastoral ministry at the church, Brother Ghassan serves as the president of Biblical Theological Seminary of Jordan. The mission of this college is twofold: “training leaders to start churches and establish ministries in the Arab world, and equipping leaders for serving in the churches already established in the Middle East.” The college currently serves 48 students representing 7 different countries.
