AM I DOING MY BEST?

"MARCH 10." FROM TRUTH FOR EACH DAY. BY VANCE HAVNER

Well done, good and faithful servant. Matthew 25:23

It will be observed that the Master said. "Well done." The good and faithful servant's work was not merely done, it was well done. The emphasis nowadays is on getting through with the job one way or another and collecting the pay. I read recently of a certain organization that threw out one of its members because he did his work too well! Evidently he was thorough and painstaking and the quality of his performance showed up his coworkers to their chagrin.

There is much shoddy Christian living these days, building with wood, hay and stubble instead of gold, silver and precious stones. There is an abundance of cheap Christianity, with just enough prayer and Bible reading and service to get by. It will be done one day but not well done. In this machine age few take the pride in their work that the old craftsmen and artists showed in turning out almost flawless masterpieces. Something of the same spirit has entered into the spiritual and few Christians give their best to the Master. We are not doing our human best sanctified by His Spirit. Low-grade Christian living is our shame in the church today. There is work aplenty, but so often it is routine and perfunctory.

When your task is finished, will it be merely done—or will it merit His "well done?"

And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men; Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ.
